

## The Platform

The first version of the database is the result of a previous Equal project in France, "Inserweb", used at a national level, during this new project will be enriched with the database in the framework of the "Inser.net".

During the project the existing database will be developed into an e-learning tool for training and integration professionals by transferring this e-learning tool to new countries, new targets, new sectors into an electronic pathway composed of:

- online self-training modules
- an European community of training and integration professionals
- an European social-professional insertion professional online certificate

The direct targets of the project will be the training and social-professional integration agents. The final beneficiaries will be persons with difficulties of professional and social integration (migrants, disabled people, long-term unemployed people, young people, senior worker...)

## The Project

The STEP INSER project is based on the experience of an innovative platform of documentary resources INSERWEB which was developed during a previous EQUAL project (INSER.NET) at French level where there is no platform tailored to the needs of the persons in charge of socio-professional insertion. This lack and the inexistent specific training for trainers and socio-professional inclusion counsellors were the two main reasons to present the STEP INSER project to the Leonardo Programme.

### AIMS

- Improving the competences to the European professionals working in the field of social and professional insertion with a self-training tool which enables them to increase their skills.
- Organize their profession at European level through the establishment of a common framework for the skills of "responsible for training and employability".

### BENEFICIARIES

The trainer and social-professional counsellors directly involved in this project. Indirectly, the project will benefit people in extreme difficulty of insertion: long-term unemployed, unskilled youth, migrants, persons without training or with a low level of qualification...

### PRODUCTS

- An European platform of information resources located in 4 languages with various media. It is a comprehensive base of pedagogical and informative resources used by responsible for training and integration. This structure will be disseminated with the help of a database including trainers and social-integration professionals from 5 European countries.
- An e-learning module. Module enriched by the diversity and relevance of the resources of the European platform that will be used to train trainers and social-professional counsellors.
- An European virtual community. This forum is intended to allow professionals to exchange best practices with peers in Europe.
